



## Summary Comments of Public Workshop #1 and Open City Hall Forum

Thank you to all the citizens who attended the workshop held on November 12, 2009 and provided the City of Decatur with valuable input with regards to the railroad crossing at Candler and McDonough Streets adjacent to downtown Decatur. Below is a summary of the meeting and the comments received.

- 38 Citizens signed in at the public meeting
- 29 Comment Cards were received at the public meeting
- 9 Comment Cards were received during the comment period after the meeting
- 27 Citizens participated in Decatur's on-line Open City Hall Forum discussion

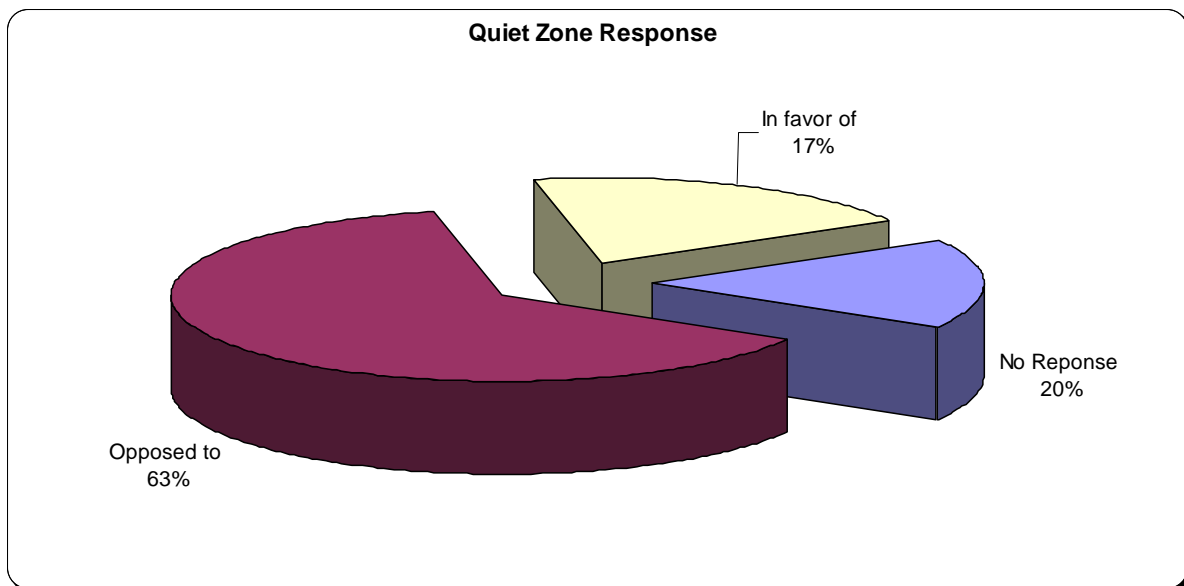
Which modes of transportation do you/family use to cross the railroad at these intersections? (More than one mode can be selected)

- 91% cross the tracks in a vehicle
- 66% cross the tracks on a bicycle
- 74% cross the tracks on foot
- 11% cross the tracks in a bus.

Which mode of transportation do you feel is most dangerous at Candler Street?  
46% on foot, 29% on a bicycle, 3% in a vehicle

Which mode of transportation do you feel is most dangerous at McDonough Street?  
40% on foot, 23% on a bicycle, 6% in a vehicle
